We are searching for eastern-living Métis to participate in a qualitative study as a means to document their experiences. While a rich history exists on Métis in the west (e.g., Métis homeland), less is known about Métis who live in Ontario, Québec and the Maritime provinces. The purpose of this study is to document and write about the collective stories of eastern Métis (e.g., what it means to be Métis, your life experiences, your culture, your history).

You are not required to hold a membership in any Métis organisation to participate in this study.

Telling us your Métis story will expand on what is known about Métis-identified peoples in Canada in general.
